Hi Ron - A follow up to our recent conversation about the use of Renovate granular to control the abundant Milfoil growing in the lake. As you know, we applied Renovate granular last summer to about 100 s/a of milfoil in Lake Angelus. The treatment was a complete success. 2 months post treatment no viable milfoil was detected growing in the lake.

Renovate is an effective systemic herbicide particularly at controlling Milfoil. This product is approved for use in Michigan waters by the EPA, Michigan Department of Agriculture, and the MDEQ.

The water use restrictions are:

Swimming	24 hours no swimming (DEQ rule)
Established Turf	No watering restriction
Ornamentals	Watering ok below 1 ppm
Domestic/Aq	Watering ok below 1 ppm
Livestock	Watering ok below 1 ppm
Fishing	No restriction

We've applied Renovate to local lake for several years and it should be noted that we have never been informed that this product has caused damage to turf, ornamental s, trees, or other landscaping plants. Our general practice is to tell lake residence to wait 7 to 10 days before watering. Many begin watering the same day of application. However the lake Angelus group, because of the political environment, decided to be extra cautious regarding watering. Therefore, a series of water samples was conducted post treatment at Lake Angelus. 7 days post, 14 days post, 30 days post, and 60 days post. The results showed a general reduction of Renovate residue in the safe watering range about 30 days post application**.

**It should be noted that the tests drawn directly over the treated milfoil beds, not near shore where waters would be drawn from the lake. In some locations, the treated plant beds where located a hundred feet or more from shore.

A good strategy would be to harvest the dying plants about 3 weeks post Renovate application.
